Our program will feature Mr. Ed Harrelson—"Third Continental Light Dragons"

Edward Harrelson is a local attorney with Coiner, Harrelson & Shelton. He has been engaged in the private practice of law in Hendersonville since 1993, focusing on Real Estate, Estate Planning and Small Business law. His undergraduate degree in History is from the University of N.C. at Chapel Hill, and he received his Law Degree from the UNC School of Law.

Since 1994, Edward has participated in cavalry living history, either portraying a trooper in the War Between the States or a dragoon during the American Revolutionary War. He is a member of the Third Continental Light Dragons, though his unit also portrays British Legion when necessary. The Third Dragons regularly recreate the historic battle at Guilford Courthouse (NC) and they annually commemorate the battle of Cowpens (SC). They have travelled to fields in Virginia, Pennsylvania and Delaware.
