Our Aug 19th program will feature Detective Jeff Brooks, Henderson County Sheriff's Office

Topic: *The Local Threat of the Islamic State (ISIS)*

From 2012 to 2016, Jeff was assigned to the FBI Joint Terrorism Task Force working on national security and counter-terrorism cases. Prior to coming to Henderson County, Jeff was assigned to the FBI Joint Terrorism Task Force in the Boston Division. He has worked on hundreds of national security and counter-terrorism investigations involving domestic and international networks and individuals, with threats ranging from weapons of mass destruction, material support for terrorism, conspiracy, money laundering and other crimes. Jeff's presentation is intended to increase the ability of attendees to recognize local ISIS or other threat-related activities. Before entering law enforcement Jeff had a 25-year career as a communications consultant for corporate, defense and military clients. Henderson County **Sheriff Charles McDonald** will also attend.

John Pinckney Clement III

John Pinckney III, a long time summer resident of Saluda, NC, died on June 30, 2016, in Hendersonville, NC, after a short illness. Mr. Clement, the son of Colonel Joseph Taylor Clement and Vilma Louise Wallace, MD, was born January 19, 1937, in Washington, D.C. He grew up on East Bay Street Charleston, SC. He attended Clemson University graduating in 1958, with a degree in Civil Engineering. After graduation he entered the US Army. He was a combat engineer unit commander and parachutist serving in Germany, Vietnam and New Guinea. In addition to other medals, he also received the Bronze Star.

While in the Army he earned a Master's Degree in Astrodynamics from UCLA in 1963, and a Bachelor of Law Degree from La Salle University in Chicago. He continued serving in the reserves for 30 years, retiring at the rank of Colonel. After his active service in the Army, he had a long civilian career with Exxon Corporation serving as vice president of domestic and international oil exploration.

During his retirement summers in Saluda, NC, he was socially active in the town. He was a bridge and poker player with his many friends. He was also active in his church in Saluda and with the church men's club. He is best remembered for his affectionate, disarming smile, genuine laughter, and pervasive generosity. Mr Clement married the former Cloeann McDowell on June 29, 1963, and they celebrated their 53rd wedding anniversary the day before he died. He is survived by his widow, a daughter, Ashleyann Clement of Denver, CO, and a son, Dr. John Pinckney Clement IV and his wife Susan of San Antonio, TX. He was also blessed with four grandchildren.

Burial will be at Arlington National Cemetery in Washington at a later date.

Tom Moore Davis

Tom Moore Davis died Saturday, April 2, 2016, at the JF Keever Solace Center. He was preceded in death by his wife, Frances King Davis, who died in 2014. He was also preceded in death by his parents, William Burch Davis and Olive L. Norton Davis, his sisters, Maurine and Martha. He is survived by his daughter, Katherine and her husband, John, a sister, Alice, and many nieces and nephews and their families.

Tom was born November 15, 1922, in Sylva, NC, and lived there the first nine years of his life when his family relocated to Shelby, NC. He graduated from Shelby High School and attended Mars Hill College and the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill majoring in Business Administration. He was commissioned a naval aviator in 1943, and served in the Pacific Theater during World War II. He was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross, four Air Medals and numerous other medals for combat against the Japanese. He continued on active naval service for twenty-six years and retired in 1968.

Following retirement from naval service, he served as Chief Pilot for Baker Wibberley and Associates in Hagerstown, Maryland, for several years. He was a member of Hagerstown Rotary Club and a member of Fountain Head Country Club. Following retirement from active aviation, he lived in Asheville, NC, and Ponte Vedra Beach, Florida. He attended Central United Methodist Church and was a member of Biltmore Forest Country Club and the Sawgrass Country Club in Ponte Vedra Beach, Florida. He served on the Mars Hill College Board of Advisors for several years and was a loyal benefactor of that institution where he endowed several scholarships. A private, family interment will take place in the Western Carolina State Veterans Cemetery in Black Mountain.
