Regular membership dues may now be paid by credit card. Log on to www.MOAA.org. Select **Chapters** from the drop down tab at the top of the page. When on the Chapters page, select **Online Chapter Dues Payment**. Complete the form and your dues will be paid for the year. You have just saved time and postage. You can only pay for the current year. Auxiliary Members are not eligible for this service. **Please note that chapter regular member's dues have been **increased** from \$25 to \$30 per year beginning January 1, 2016, when they are due and payable. Feb 20th Meeting

Our program will feature Hon. David Fox.

David is an expert in NC Civil War history and an avid life-long collector of militaria, a lot of which is on display in the Heritage Museum. He will be making a presentation on Stoneman's raid that occurred in April 1865 in Western NC.

Below is David's brief Bio.

My Granddad, son of a Civil War veteran of Antietam and Fredericksburg, encouraged our mutual interest in his father's war. He and my grandmother took me on trips visiting battlefields each spring from my 5th grade through high school. Grandmother was an antique hound. There were no interstates then; we stopped at every antique shop in every town we passed through. Those shops often had umbrella stands full of \$15 swords and \$50 muskets standing in corners. I saved money from lawn mowing and caddying all year and began my accumulation in 1955...and haven't stopped collecting and studying America's wars in the 60 years since. I enlisted in the Army in 1967 and acted as an artillery recon sergeant and forward observer with Airmobile and Riverine forces in the Mekong Delta in 1968.



I attended law school at Chapel Hill on the GI Bill. I served as an assistant DA; I have 20 years of private practice, and I was a trial judge for 16 years. My primary hobby is shooting 19th Century weaponry.

The Steadfast House:

A Residence for Female Homeless Veterans

Steadfast House is the only facility in the Asheville/Hendersonville area that provides shelter for homeless women and children, including homeless female veterans. While it is associated with ABCCM, it doesn't receive anywhere near the level of support that the VRQ does. As of December 15, 2015, there were eleven veterans at the House.

I am hoping that WNC MOAA members will consider contributing to the Steadfast House on behalf of their female veteran residents. 50th Anniversary Vietnam War Commemoration

In 2008, Congress passed legislation authorizing the Secretary of Defense to conduct a program to commemorate the 50th anniversary of the Vietnam War; this program runs through 2017. The NC Council of Chapters of the Military Officers Association of America is a registered partner in this program. At the NC Council of Chapters meeting in Charlotte on January 8th, Vietnam veterans were presented a commemorative pin in recognition of their service in the War.
